QUICK RULES & INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION



TopClass Races

- Prize money up to 20'000 USD
- Points for places 1 – 50 (for the TopClass races in countries outside Europe the points are multiplied with the factor 1.2).
- For the final race the points will be multiplied with the factor 1.4.

Class1 Races

- Prize money up to 5'000 EUR
- Points for places 1 - 20

WIC Season End Prize Money

- 10'000 USD
- In order to be eligible for full WIC Season End Prize Money skaters have to register for a minimum of three races directly via the WIC using the [WIC website](#).
- Skaters who have registered for less than three races via the WIC homepage (or less than two via the WIC homepage + BMW BERLIN MARATHON INLINESKATING via organizer) will still receive 50% of the WIC Season End Prize money of their respective rank.

Total Prize Money for all races and WIC Season End Prize Money

- 83'000 USD

Hotels

- Accommodation for two nights will be paid by local organizer for WIC licensed athletes of TopClass races outside of Europe.

LICENCES

WORLD INLINE CUP License

- An individual license for the entire season is 59,- EUR per athlete (**only to be paid after achieving a place entitling to prize money**).
- 59,- EUR for each WIC Team, registration and payment via [\[\[LINK\]\]](#) at latest one week prior to a race.

WIC race registration

Registration via WIC website or local organizer

Registration fees via [WIC website](#)

- 45,- EUR for a Class1 race (35,- for Juniors)
- 59,- EUR for a TopClass race (45,- for Juniors)

WHAT IS NEW IN 2017?

- All participants of WIC races are WIC starters.
- A ranking for Juniors (16-19) will be introduced.
- WIC license per athlete has to be paid only after winning prize money.
- Lower WIC team license has to be paid (59 EUR).
- Starters can register on [WIC homepage](#) or via local organizer.
- Professional skaters and teams intending to participate on WIC end prize money have to handle the race registration via [WIC homepage](#) for 3 WIC races minimum.
- Different registration fees for TopClass (59 EUR) and Class1 (45 EUR) races, including VAT.
- Different race registration fees for Juniors (1998-2001) (35 EUR for Class1 and 45 EUR for TopClass)
