The organizer offers free rooms for complete teams (4 women/5 men), of which at least **two women or men** have been ranked in the **top 17** during one of the last two BMW BERLIN-MARATHON races (2018 or 2019).

Teams that do not meet these criteria are asked to book accommodation on their own. The organizer does not hold any further contingents for this.

For the top 17 teams mentioned above, a shuttle service is provided between the airport/main station and the partner hotel. The service has to be booked via the organizer up to September 3. Due to the running marathon on Sunday, shuttle service is only available until Saturday morning.

On race day, there will be no shuttle service between the partner hotel and the start/finish area. Teams are asked to cover the distance on skates (2,6 km passing some of Berlin's most iconic sights).
